

Literacy

Themes: *Exploring day and night themed books. Celebrating festivals (Christmas and Diwali).*



- * Children will follow rhythm in songs and poems.
- * Will be able to use intonation when re-telling the story.
- * Take part in discussions about a story.
- * Will use intonation to show what characters are feeling.
- * Begin to understand that the print is telling a story.
- * Will enjoy picture and tell stories from what they see.
- * Children will hold and care for a book.
- * Children will have some phonetical awareness and enjoy doing Robbie Robot.
- * Will begin to recognise and write their names.
- * Will start to have some knowledge of letters.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- * Will be more familiar with the routines in the nursery.
- * Will be more aware of managing them themselves (brushing teeth, dressing and toilet care).
- * Will be more aware of their own emotions and those of others.
- * Will become more confident at talking about how they feel.
- * Will be aware of the people around them and how they look and feel.
- * Will be confident at building relationships.



Maths

- * Will sing a range of number songs
- * Children will explore the number 1 (subitising, counting & the numeral).
- * Children will explore the number 2 (subitising, counting & the numeral).
- * Will explore 1 & 2 in a range of contexts.
- * Will explore repeating patterns inside and outside.
- * Will correct repeating patterns.
- * Will extend pattern knowledge to ABC.

Understanding of the World

- * Children will use their senses to explore different materials in the natural world.
- * Will become confident at discussing choices and what they notice.
- * Explore how things work.
- * Explore and talk about different forces they can feel.
- * Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.
- * Explore day and night routines.



Communication & Language



- * Children will be able to listen and respond. Will be more aware of one conversation and through talk will show understanding.
- * Speech will improve; staff will model and re-cast correct speech.
- * Will build up a real love of stories and with support will be more confident to discuss the story line and talk about the characters.
- * Will be more confident at talking to others.
- * In Phonics children will cover initial sounds: s a t p i n

Physical Development

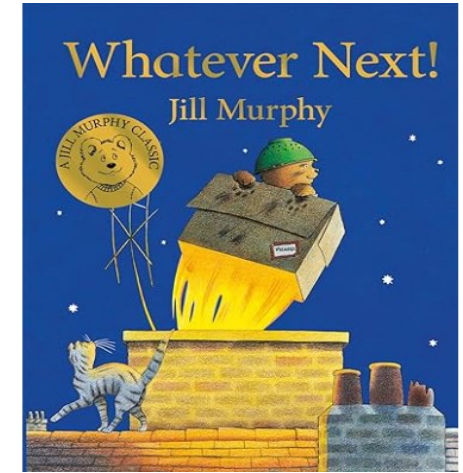
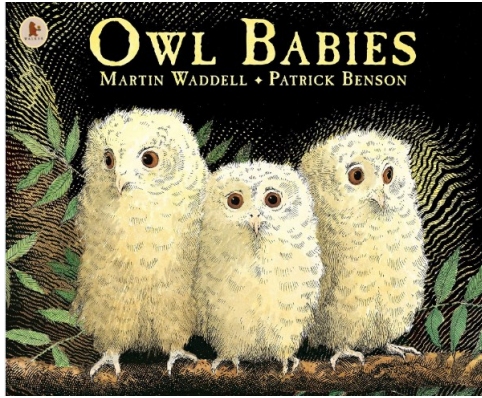
- * Will begin to enjoy throwing and catching.
- * Will develop both fine and big movements through a range of physical play.
- * Will be more confident about being precise about fine movement through building and constructing.



Expressive Arts & Design

- * Children will make rhythmical and repetitive sounds.
- * Will explore a range of sound makers and instruments and play them in different ways.
- * Will be more confident to choose and use resources creating their own designs in art and select material to join junk modelling together.
- * Will gain confidence in linking role play to art, expressing preference..
- * Will use different resources to express their thoughts and ideas.
- * Will start to experiment with establishing rules and responsibilities during role play.
